Credit card numbers and other personal information from several hundred Portland Center for the Performing Arts customers have been stolen due to a breach of website security, the center announced Friday. Ticket purchases for PCPA events, which are handled exclusively through Ticketmaster, were not affected. The problem was with the PCPA's own site and records of 864 gift-card purchases from January 1, 2006 to March 15, 2011. The information accessed without authorization includes names, street and email addresses, phone and credit card numbers, card types, expiration dates and billing addresses.

A student analyzing the data found the numbers and alerted the college on March 24, said Fiscal Services Director Jonah Nicholas. The records also included legal names of students since 2000, along with their corresponding student identification numbers.

A BP employee lost a laptop containing personal data belonging to thousands of residents who filed claims for compensation after the Gulf oil spill, a company spokesman said Tuesday. BP spokesman Curtis Thomas said the oil giant on Monday mailed out letters to roughly 13,000 people whose names, Social Security numbers, phone numbers and addresses were stored on the computer. The data belonged to individuals who filed claims with BP before the Gulf Coast Claims Facility took over the processing of claims in August. BP paid roughly \$400 million in claims before the switch.

It was discovered that the company filled several dumpsters already collected as recycle. It is recommended that if you're an employee or former employee of Lone Star Steakhouse you should monitor your credit closely. The group's restaurants include Lone Star Steakhouse & Saloon, Texas Land & Cattle Steak House, Del Frisco's Double Eagle Steak House and Sullivan's Steakhouse. Despite a thorough search and investigation, the missing cards have not been found. While not visible, embedded in the mag strip that can be read by some over the counter barcode readers is the SSN and date of birth of the Vet. According to the letter dated March 8, computers and hard drives stolen during the break-in included names, addresses, and Social Security numbers of an unspecified number of people. The drives were password-protected and it "required specialized accounting software" to access the files. The police were able to recover all of the hardware that had contained personally identifiable information. Two of the drives, however, had had the data overwritten by new programs and data. The suspects reportedly informed police that they had never attempted to access the information on the drives and were only interested in reselling the equipment.

According to a letter sent to the state on December 30, on December 12, PenFed discovered that a laptop had been infected with malware. The compromise allowed access to a database containing names, addresses, Social Security Numbers, credit card and/or debit card numbers, and PenFed account numbers for PenFed members, joint owners, former members, employees, and beneficiaries. No PINs or passwords were accessed or acquired. Although the total number of individuals affected was not indicated, 514 residents of New Hampshire were among those affected.

Update: The full extent of the breach may not be known for years, security experts said. PenFed serves almost one million members of the active-duty military, Department of Defense, Coast Guard, Department of Homeland Security and the Veterans of Foreign Wars. Its customers also include defense contractors. The credit union offers mortgages, loans, credit cards, home equity lines of credit and other financial services, often at lower rates than traditional banks. It has more than \$15 billion in assets, according to its Web site.

According to the letter, the company noticed on November 18 that a steel cabinet that contained a safe with backup tapes was missing. The ITRC Breach database is updated on a daily basis, and published to our website on each Tuesday. Unless noted otherwise, each report includes breaches that occurred in the year of the report name (such as "2009 Breach List"), or became public in the report name year, but were not public in the previous year. Each item must be previously published by a credible source, such as Attorney General's website, TV, radio, press, etc. The item will not be included at all if ITRC is not certain that the source is real and credible. We include in each item a link or source of the article, and the information presented by that article. Many times, we have attributions from a multitude of media sources and media outlets. ITRC sticks to the facts as reported, and does not add or subtract from the previously published information. When the number of exposed records is not reported, we note that fact. When records are encrypted, we state that we do not (at this time) consider that to be a data exposure. However, we do not consider password protection as adequate, and we do consider those events to be a data exposure.

What is a breach? A breach is defined as an event in which an individual's name plus Social Security Number (SSN), driver's license number, medical record, or a financial record/credit/debit card is potentially put at risk – either in electronic or paper format.

The ITRC Breach Report presents individual information about data exposure events and running totals for the year. The ITRC Breach Stats Report develops some statistics based upon the type of entity involved in the data exposure.
